

IDI QUICKSTART: BRADY TAG COMMANDER

LOADING ANDROID APPLICATION FILE ONTO ALIEN ALR-H460

It is very likely that Brady's Tag Commander Application is preinstalled on an end user's Alien H460 reader. If it isn't, or if one needs to reinstall or update the program, the following procedure should be used.

Begin by downloading the TagCommander.apk program file from a support email request. Once on a Win10 computer, you can then copy that file onto a micro SD memory card using either your laptop's slot or PC's SD card adapter.

Transfer the micro SD card to the Alien H460 and install in the slot as shown below (from Alien User Manual):

SIM and microSD Card Installation

Access to the SIM and microSD card carrier is on the right-side of the H460 data terminal. Remove the plastic cover by pulling the right-hand side of the cover until the outside of the slot is visible.



Once the cover is removed, use the included SIM card removal tool to push into the release slot which will push the carrier out. The carrier may be pulled out at this point. Please note that the carrier is "upside down" and when re-inserting with cards in place, ensure that the device itself is facing down, so the cards stay in place. Push the carrier in completely, replace the plastic cover and the device is now ready to use with the cards inserted.



INSTALLATION OF TAGCOMMANDER.APK PROGRAM

Using the Alien's Android File Manager app, locate the .apk file on the installed micro SD card, and double-click the file to begin the installation. When complete, an icon for the program will appear on the home screen of the H460.

CONFIGURATION

The program can be started with a double tap on the desktop icon. Configuration is not usually necessary. However, such options are covered in the Tag Commander User Manual.
